



## SUMMER HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES 2020

They will be re-opening select Holiday Camps this Summer Holidays with new measures in place to ensure their camps are Covid-19 friendly and follow all guidance to maintain a safe environment for parents, children and staff.

Camps open to children from all schools aged 4-13 years old. All programmes are Ofsted Registered and accept Child Care vouchers and Tax Free Credits.

**Reduced capacity** – places will be limited to 30 per venue with children kept in small bubbles of no more than 15 children.

Regular hand washing and hygiene routines will be in place.

**Staff working for Multi-Active** – checks will take place to ensure staff are fit for work. Staff will remain within bubbles with children and have appropriate PPE equipment. Staff will conduct increased cleaning routines to keep areas clean and safe.

**Parents** – sign in and out will take place outside. Signing in will take place contactless with 2m distance. Temperature checks will be taken on arrival as a precaution. There will be an increased flexibility for parents with cancellations due to Covid-19.

**Activities** – The programme is being re-designed to enable children to participate in fun activities that adheres to 2m social distancing and makes use of the outdoors more. They won't be running any themed days but will incorporate these activities into the day. A timetable will be released nearer the time.
